Description

Moving on, Moving up (MoMu) is an evidence-based, small group intervention created by Gloucestershire Educational Psychology Service to support vulnerable Year 6 students as they transition to secondary school.

The programme focuses on helping children to develop a sense of belonging in their new school and the skills to build positive relationships with new adults and peers. It also aims to equip children with the tools to navigate a new environment successfully, whilst increasing confidence.
