

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL CORPORATE MANAGEMENT TEAM SALARIES



The County Council is responsible for providing a range of strategic services for the people of Gloucestershire, a county of approximately 500,000 people. The county is accountable for services to children and families including accountability for safeguarding and ensuring that all children receive access to a good education; adult social care; highway maintenance; planning; economic development; waste management and libraries. There are 298 county schools which educate 81374 children. Some of these services are delivered through contracts with individual companies or through partners. 85% of our budget is spent on adult social care and children and families.

The council is one of the largest employers in the county, employing some 17,000 people (including staff in schools) and manages a gross budget of £995 million (2010/11).
