## **4 Vision 2050**

Consideration was given to papers circulated with the agenda including the Validity Framework, Delivery Vehicle, Big Conversation main report and related appendices and the draft Concordat.

Stephen Marston explained that the Concordat was intended to capture the thinking and contributions from the Gloucestershire community in a single place. He hoped that all the partners would feel broadly comfortable with it in setting out a mandate for taking Gloucestershire Vision 2050 forward.

After a lengthy discussion regarding different aspects of the Concordat, a series of revisions were suggested. Pete Bungard undertook to circulate an updated version following the meeting for comment.

### ***Decision***

- a) Leadership Gloucestershire welcomes and notes the three reports and will move forward with the proposed Concordat noting the timescales stated within it. This is subject to an opportunity for Leadership Gloucestershire members to check the amended version of the proposed Concordat.*
- b) The University and the County Council will facilitate a media launch of the reports and the Concordat. The launch will take place during the week starting 22 October 2018.*
