APPLICATION FOR PREMISES TO BE APPROVED AS A VENUE FOR MARRIAGES AND CIVIL PARTNERSHIP CEREMONIES

Notice is given that the proprietors of **Lords of the Manor** have applied for the parts of those premises known as **Drawing Room (occupancy 40)**, **Garden Room (occupancy 50)**, **Atrium (occupancy 50)** and **The Dining Room (occupancy 84)** to be approved as venues for marriages in pursuance of Section 26(1)(bb) of the Marriage Act. 1949 and Section 6 (3A)(a) of the Civil Partnership Act 2004. The application is to renew for a further three years an approval that is due to expire on **1st December 2025**.

They should be addressed to the undersigned to arrive **within 21 days** of the date of publication of this notice (publication date = **5th January 2026**). Any objection received will become a public document, and a copy of the objection will be made available to the applicant.
