Browse the bustling **Cirencester Markets**, where local produce, artisan goods and independent traders showcase the best of the Cotswolds.

Enjoy an evening at the **Barn Theatre**, an award-winning venue bringing world-class productions to Cirencester.

Step back in time at the **Corinium Museum**, where fascinating artefacts bring 2,000 years of history to life. Combine with a walk to the **Cirencester Amphitheatre**.

Get creative at **New Brewery Arts**, where local artists, independent makers and hands-on workshops inspire visitors of all ages.

- These experiences, along with many more of Cirencester's attractions, are within a 10-minute walk from 'The Forum' bus stop in the town centre.

Outdoors & Nature

Stretch your legs in **Cirencester Park**, a historic estate with plenty of space to explore and enjoy the outdoors.

- Get there on the 50 bus from 'The Forum', exiting at 'Chesterton Cemetery', followed by an 8-minute walk.

Explore beyond Cirencester, and follow the trail to the **source of the Thames**, set amongst the beautiful Cotswolds countryside.

- A 1-hr walking route is accessible from Kemble Railway Station. Get there on the 882 bus from 'The Forum'.

Days Out

Make a splash at **Cotswold Water Park**, offering outdoor adventure for all ages.

- Get there on the 51 bus towards Swindon from 'The Forum', exiting at 'Windrush Lakes', followed by a short walk.

With picturesque villages at your doorstep, why not explore **Bibury** by bus for a memorable day out?

- Get there on the 855 bus towards Bourton-on-the-Water from 'The Forum', exiting at 'The Square'.

Spend an afternoon exploring **Cerney House Gardens**, smelling the flowers and walking through woodlands. Don't miss the tea room!

- Get there on the 51 bus towards Cheltenham, exiting at 'Bathurst Arms', followed by a 10-minute walk.

Cirencester is well-connected to Gloucestershire's other urban centres.

- Cheltenham: 51 bus service
- Gloucester: 882 bus service
- Stroud: 54 and 959 services
