

Physical training makes up 50% of the course.

Weekly Military Training.

Monthly Careers sessions

The course is free and no entry requirements needed

The programme includes physical exercise and personal development. Building Team work and communication Skills as well as Maths and English and NVQ Level 2 in Preparation for Military

The college cover modules such as:

- Communication skills for the military
- Teamwork skills for the military
- Health and Safety
- Navigation/Field Craft skills
- Leadership skills for the military
- Fitness for the military
- Understanding the industry

This is an example of their day-to-day timetable:

Morning:

- Breakfast is supplied between 0830 – 0900.
- Classwork until lunchtime.
- Lunchtime: Allowed to go out for food/drink.

Afternoon:

- Physical Training Activities this can be anything from circuit training in a studio at the leisure centre (GL1) , swimming, boxing fitness etc.
- Team-building activities, such as carrying logs in groups (Log PT).

The college hold special careers days where Military, Navy, and Aircraft staff conduct mock interviews and presentations. There are occasional day visits/trips to military sites for career awareness and learners also get the chance to meet serving soldiers etc who come in occasionally to do career presentations and hear all about life in the forces. The college staff are all ex military too

You should receive a call within 3 working days to discuss your referral

This is run by the Employment and Skills Hub which is part of the county council.

This is a new scheme support 100 young people to take part in a 6 week work experience

What:

The placement aims to help build skills, awareness and confidence to move into paid employment

They are expected to do 16 hours a week

If there is a placement you would like to do which is not in your area, then they can provide smart travel cards

The scheme will help build a vocational profile, CV and progression plan to move into employment

The hub will stay in touch throughout the placement.

After:

Once the placement is completed you will receive £100

You can spend this through the council (e.g. you would like a new pair of trainers or phone then they will contribute £100)

You will be referred to one of their career advisers / mentors to help find paid employment

If you find paid employment within 3 months you will receive another £100



5 Ways to Find an Apprenticeship

What is an Apprenticeship?

- A job where you learn, gain experience, qualifications.
- You are an employee and are entitled to holiday leave and other benefits.
- You will complete part time studying for a qualification linked to the job that you are doing, either in the workplace, or at a local college or specialist training provider

Key Facts

- An apprenticeship takes a minimum of one year to complete.
- Minimum wage for an apprenticeship up to 17 is £6.40 per hour; (£8.60 per hour – 18–20-year-olds). the average apprenticeship wage is around £200 per week.
- Apprenticeships have entry criteria, you may need certain grades in Maths and English before being able to start
