

Gloucestershire County Council Waste Core Strategy (WCS)

Adoption Statement November 2012

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 that the Gloucestershire Waste Core Strategy (WCS) was adopted by Gloucestershire County Council on 21st November 2012. The WCS provides a planning framework for waste management across the county of Gloucestershire in the period 2012 – 2027. It identifies a number of key issues relevant to Gloucestershire and translates these into a vision, objectives and strategy.

The WCS was the subject of an independent examination conducted by an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State. The Inspector's Report was published on 3rd September 2012 and the recommended main modifications have been included in the adopted WCS. The Inspector's Report and associated background documents can be viewed at the locations below and online at www.goucestershire.gov.uk/wcs-adoption.

Any person aggrieved by the Gloucestershire Waste Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers or that a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any application must be made no later than six weeks after the date of adoption by Gloucestershire County Council.
