Outdoors & Nature

Take in spectacular views from **Cleeve Hill**, the highest point in the Cotswolds and a highlight along the iconic Cotswold Way National Trail.

- Get there on the W bus from the town centre, exiting at 'Malvern View'.

Explore **Pittville Park**, where beautiful gardens, a tranquil lake and the historic Pump Room make for a perfect day out.

- Get there on the E bus from the town centre or the train station, exiting at 'Pittville Pump Room'.

Hop off the bus and enjoy the ride on the **Gloucestershire Cycle Spine**, linking Cheltenham with Gloucester along a largely traffic-free path.

Make a splash at **Sandford Parks Lido**, home to one of the UK's largest outdoor pools.

- Get there on the L bus from Cheltenham town centre, exiting at 'Hospital Main Entrance'.

Rainy day? Try something different at **Boulders** Cheltenham's dedicated bouldering centre.

- From the town centre, get the C, L or 41, exiting at 'Kingsditch Retail Park'.

Culture & Entertainment

Discover inspiring art, fascinating local history and changing exhibitions at **The Wilson Art Gallery & Museum**.

Enjoy an unforgettable performance at the **Everyman Theatre**, Cheltenham's beautifully restored Victorian theatre.

- Both are just a 5-minute walk from the Royal Well and Promenade bus interchanges, putting you in the heart of Cheltenham's shopping, dining and cultural offer.

Days Out

Step back in time at **Sudeley Castle & Gardens**, a Tudor treasure with 1,000 years of history, stunning gardens and family-friendly adventures.

- Get there on the W bus from the town centre, exiting at 'Winchcombe War Memorial', followed by a 15-minute walk.

All aboard the **Gloucestershire Warwickshire Steam Railway** for a nostalgic journey through the Cotswolds.

- Get there on the D/E buses from the town centre, exiting at 'Racecourse Roundabout' or 'Racecourse Park and Ride', followed by a 15-minute walk.

Relax at **Dunkertons Park**, home of award-winning craft cider, independent food vendors, live music and events in a welcoming Cotswold setting.

- Get there on the 801 bus from the town centre, exiting at 'Reservoir Inn', followed by a 5-minute walk.

Getting in from out of town?

Take the train and arrive at 'Cheltenham Spa' railway station, it's just a short ride on the D/E bus service to the town centre.

Make your visit hassle-free – park at **Arle Court Transport Hub** and catch the bus into the heart of Cheltenham.
