GDPR Statement

- The legal status of your organisation
- The current activities of your organisation and how these are managed
- We will also collect any required additional supporting information including financial information about the organisation.

Our lawful basis for collecting your information is that we process your personal data under Article 6(1)(e) of the UK GDPR, as it is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest. This task is underpinned by Section 2B of the Health and Social Care Act 2012, which places a duty on local authorities to take appropriate steps to improve the health of people in their area. These steps include providing grants or loans where considered appropriate.

We will keep and use your data for the purpose of corporate decision making, HMRC compliance purposes and to comply with the Financial Services Act 1986 and Limitation Act 1980. Gloucestershire County Council will keep your personal data for the financial year that the records relate to plus a further 6 years
