Preparation for Adulthood - Education, Employment and Training (EET)

Description

This course considers factors which can promote a positive transition for post-16 students. It provides information about pathways available to young people after they finish school and move to college, employment or training, and how to support them to make informed choices, build employability and readiness skills. It will include opportunities to reflect and apply learning through case study discussions.

Outcome

Outcomes of the course:

- To explore theories relevant to post 16 transitions
- To understand the key elements of effective Education Employment and Training (EET) transition planning
- To support young people to make informed, realistic future choices
- To understand the range of post-16 and post-18 pathways
- To build employable and readiness skills in young people
- To recognise when a young person needs additional support
- To explore Case Studies to consider ideas in your own settings
