

I would however like to make one additional representation on behalf of Elliotts (Cheltenham) Limited in respect of GCC's Proposed Main Modifications dated April 2019 - modification ref PMM/09.

This modification doesn't address the points of my earlier representation (793547) and seems to shut down the possibility of any aggregate extraction outside of allocations so negating the point of the policy in the first place. That said, if the scope of criteria VII of policy MA02 was broadened this could address my concerns. For example, could the policy allow a borrow pit to serve several developments locally, isn't this just as sustainable as a pit supplying aggregates to one local development anyway?
