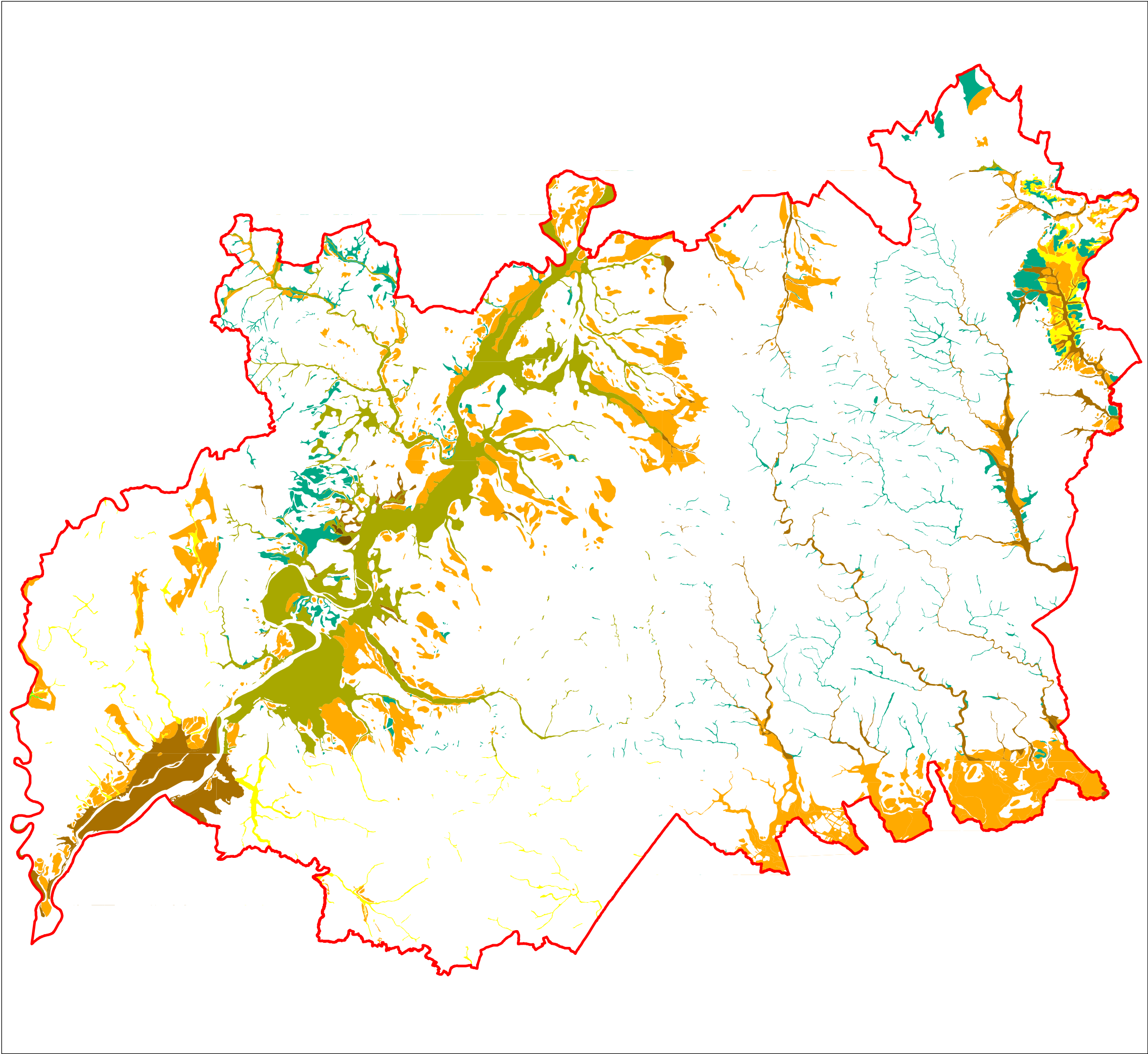

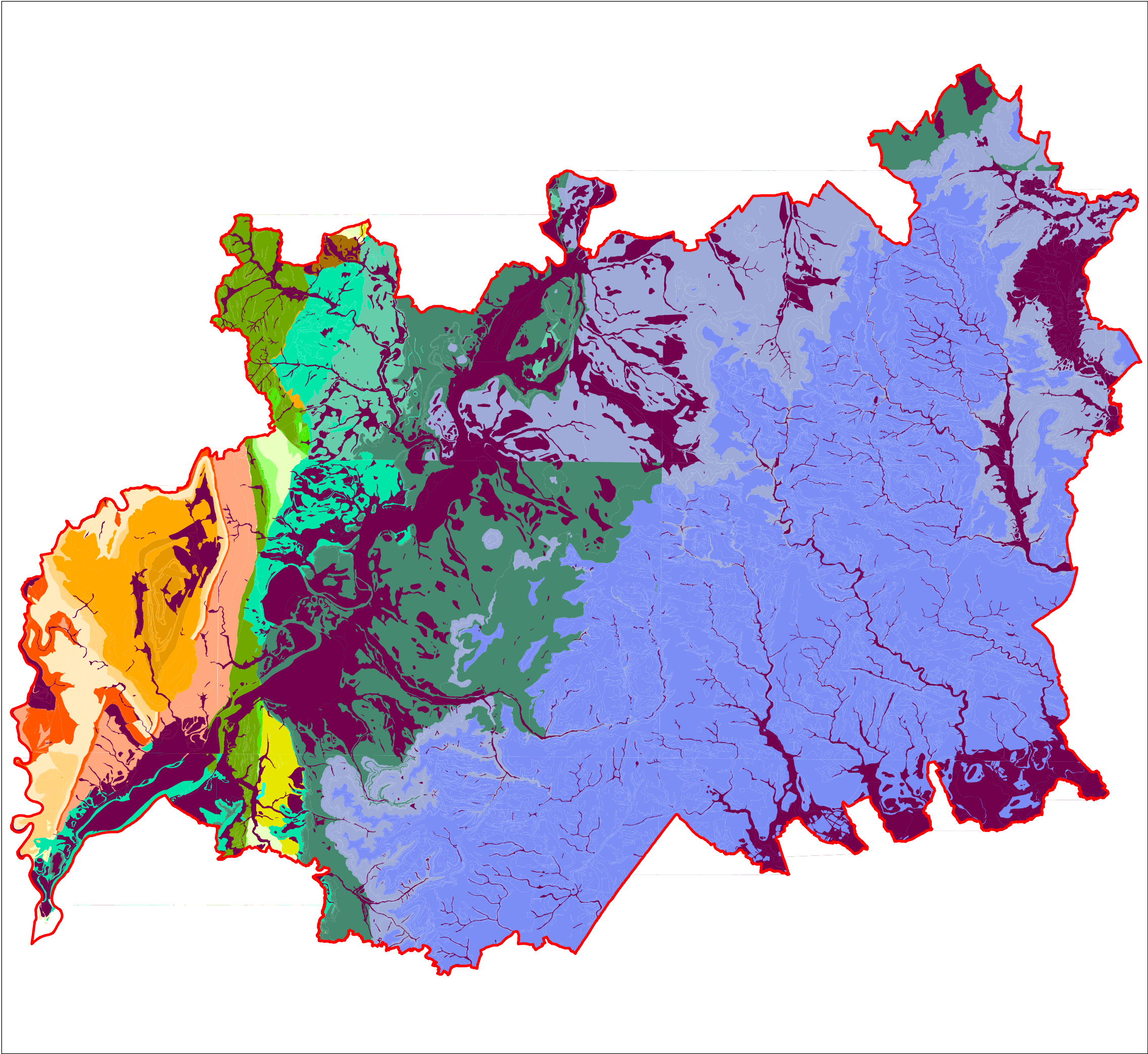

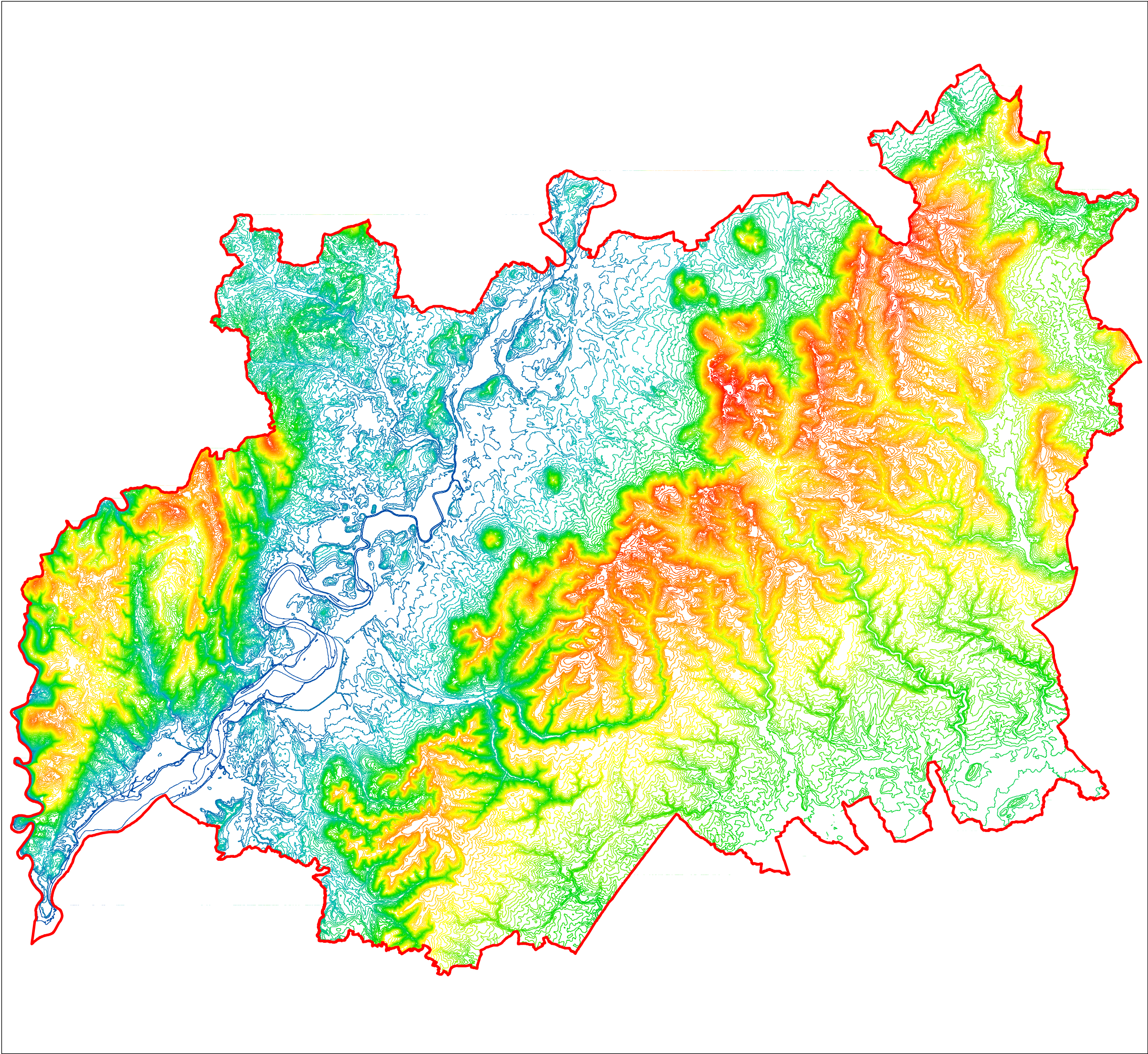

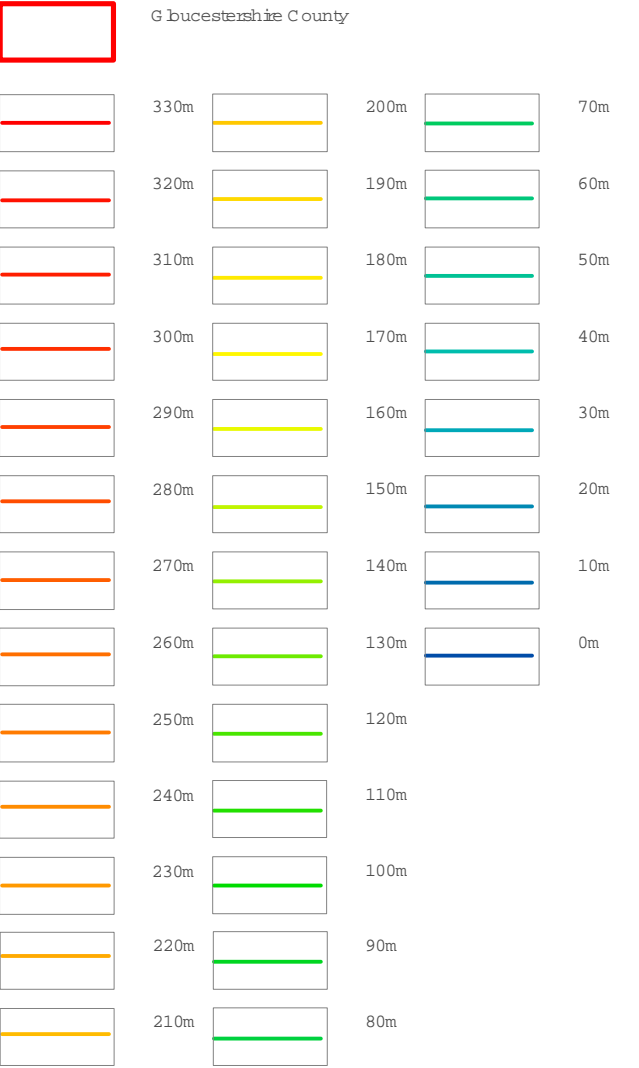
Geology - Simplified Drift and Solid

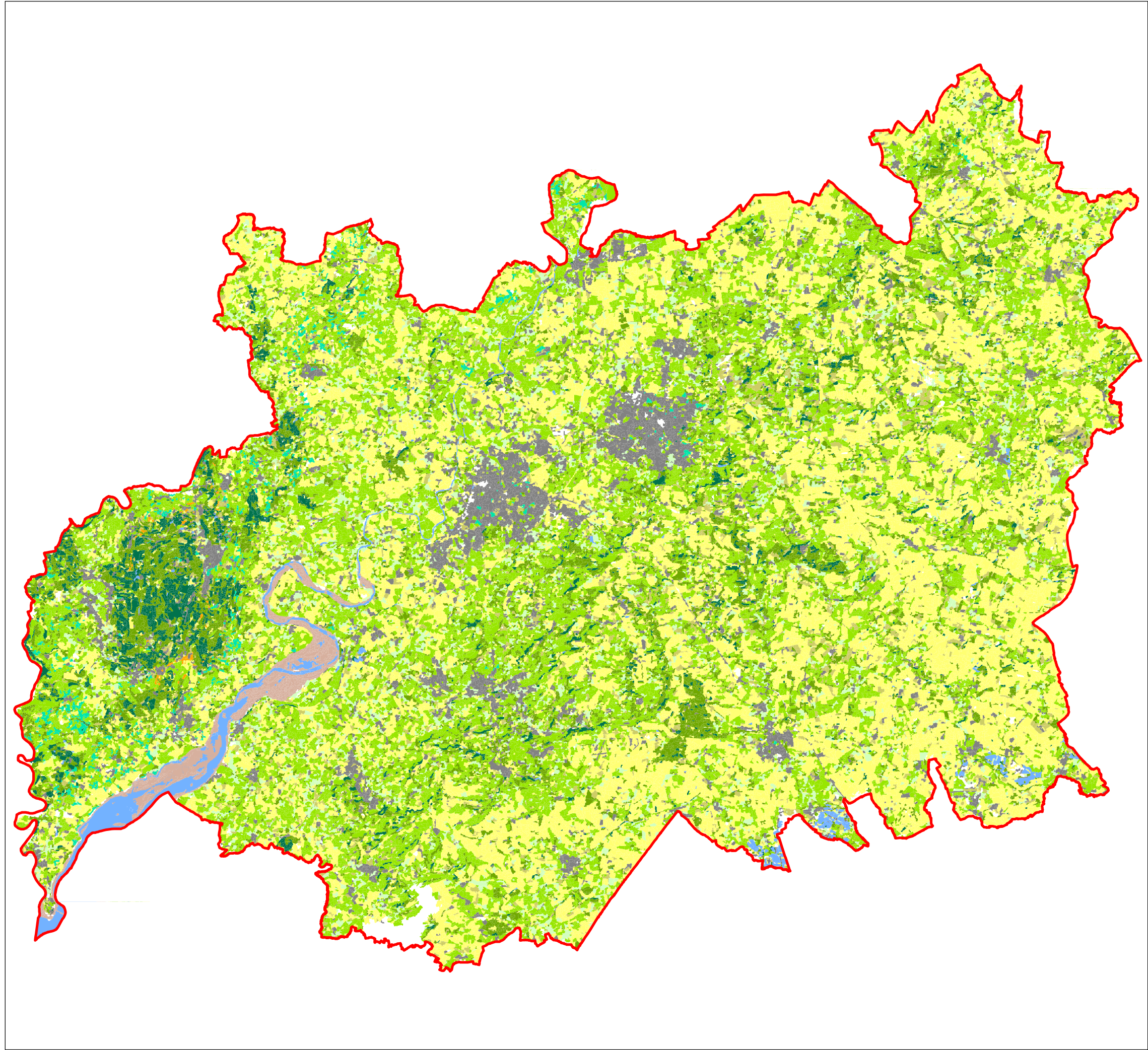

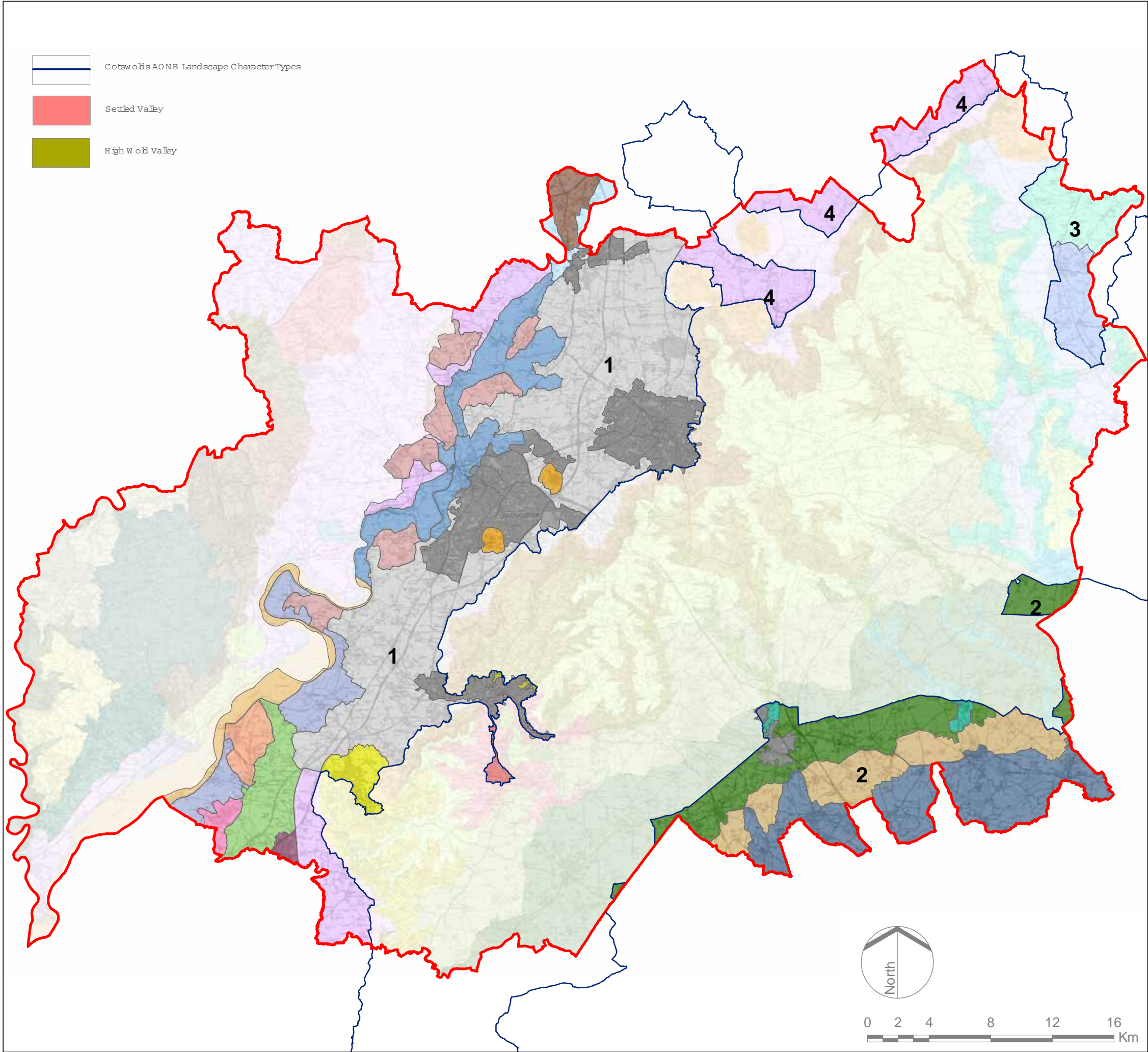
